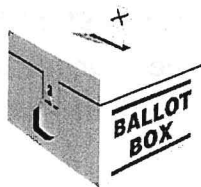

Many chatrooms and apps have an age rating as children do not yet have the social skills to manage relationships using these.

If you are allowing your child to use these facilities you need to be aware that it is also against school advice and that you need to be aware that your child may be exposed to the inappropriate behaviour of others and take responsibility for ensuring that they are safe.
