





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ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Please can I ask that all our families work hard to ensure that our children are in school all of the time and that children are NOT collected early from school on a regular basis. Yesterday afternoon we had six children collected before 3:20pm! We also have an increasing number of children absent from school due to holidays. Holidays during school time will not be authorised. Our persistent absent figure for the whole school is already 27%. This is significantly higher than the national average. Please also remember that we expect our children in Nursery to attend every day and follow the same guidelines as the rest of our school community.


