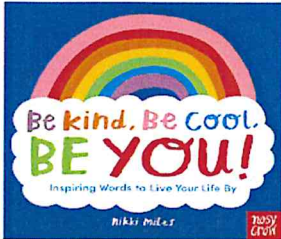

Children's Mental Health Week


5th-11th February
